

Connecting to PRSD Guest Wifi

NOTE: This procedure was written using a Windows 7 laptop. Procedure will differ slightly on other devices.

On your device, connect to the “guest” wifi network. No username or password is required.

Once connected, open a web browser (this may happen automatically after you connect to “guest”)

The following Login page should appear:

Welcome to PRSD Guest WiFi

Welcome to Pentucket's Guest Wifi Network. Authorized Use Only!

Guest users agree to the terms set forth in the District's Acceptable Use Policy. A copy of this policy is available on the PRSD website.
