The Chromebook I bought for my student is restricted when using it at home. How do I remove these restrictions?

Actually, the restriction is on the PRSD Student Accounts, and not on the Chromebook itself. With the PRSD Student Google Accounts, we restrict the ability for students to install apps so that they won't be installing all sorts of apps on our Chromebooks. Unfortunately, that restriction carries over to any device they log into with their PRSD Google Account.

To use a Chromebook without these restrictions, you must create a Google account. The easiest way to do this is to create a Gmail account.

How to create a Gmail Account for personal use: Simply follow the instructions on this website: <u>https://support.google.com/mail/answer/56256?hl=en</u>

Once you have created a Gmail account, login to the Chromebook with that account. If your student wants to access their Google Drive folder while logged in as the new user, follow these steps:

- Open Google Drive on the Chromebook <u>https://drive.google.com</u>
- In the upper right, you will see a circle with your first initial, click on that:



Click "Sign out"
